**2026 FREESTYLE PRO TOUR CHAMPIONSHIPS**

## 1. **Event Rules**

- The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Freestyle Pro Tour (FPT) Rulebook and the INTERNATIONAL FUNBOARD CLASS ASSOCIATION EXPRESSION CHAMPIONSHIP RULES 2017.
- No national prescriptions will apply.
- In case of a conflict between languages, the English version will take precedence.
- The Freestyle Pro Tour (FPT) Rulebook will apply above that of the IFCA Expression Championship Rules 2017.
- Competitors and support personnel must comply with any reasonable request from event officials. Failure to comply may be deemed misconduct. Any actions taken by event officials, even if unnecessary, will not be considered improper

## 2. **Advertising**

- Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 ('Advertising Code') will apply.
- Event branding must be worn at all times when afloat, during media interviews, and at the prize giving, as requested by the organisers.

## 3. **Divisions**

- Women's Freestyle Windsurfing
- Men's Freestyle Windsurfing
- Women's Tow-in
- Men's Tow-in

## 4. **Eligibility and Entry**

- Competitors must meet the requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- Competitors must be members of a National Class Association, which is a paid-up member of the International Class Association or the IWA.
- Eligible competitors may enter online with credit/debit card or bank transfer payment. Online entry closes on Oct 6th, 2026 at 9:00am CET.
- An entry is valid only after payment is received.
- This is an qualified and wildcard only event, no on site registration is possible.
- Pre-registration is mandatory. No on-site registration will take place — so that the event can start as soon as we arrive at the spot and make the most of the conditions.
- Registration runs in TWO TIERS. Tier 1 — Early Bird: open now, closing 24/08/2026 at 09:00 CET, and works exactly like regular pre-registration. Tier 2 — Standard Registration at full price, closing 06/10/2026 at 09:00 CET.
- Only competitors who signed up in Tier 1 receive the rider benefits: food vouchers, drinks vouchers and the discounted entry fee.
- Freestyle and Tow-in are entered separately. A competitor entering both disciplines pays one discipline entry fee only.
- The Tow-in fleets are formed from the Tier 1 early-bird entrants: the top 12 men and top 2 women. A further 4 wildcards for men and 2 for women are selected on Friday 9 October, once the freestyle results are in — giving a men's fleet of 16 and a women's fleet of 4.
- Seeded Tow-in competitors will be contacted directly to confirm their spot.

## 5. **Fees**

- Entry Fee: €110 + Membership €30 per event or €60 for the full season. Locals and Rookies pay a fee of €55.
- The entry fee above is the Tier 1 (Early Bird) price, available until 24/08/2026 at 09:00 CET.
- Tier 2 (Standard Registration) is €150, from 24/08/2026 until entry closes on 06/10/2026 at 09:00 CET.
- Membership is charged in addition at both tiers.

## 6. **Event Format**

- A women's and men's Freestyle windsurfing format, and a women's and men's Tow-in format.
- At least one completed round of an elimination is required to validate the championship.

## 7. **Sailing Instructions**

- Sailing instructions will be provided at registration. Changes will need approval from the Class Representative.
- Courses will be defined by the IFCA Championship Rules, or as described in the sailing instructions or on the official notice board.

## 8. **International Jury**

- An International Jury has been appointed. There will be no appeal against their decisions.

## 9. **Scoring**

- Scoring will follow the FPT Rulebook.

## 10. **Coaches**

- Coaches must be registered with the FPT.

## 11. **Prizes & Titles**

- Trophies will be awarded to the top three competitors in each category.
- Points will be awarded per the FPT Rulebook.
- The total prize fund is €5,000
- The total prize pool is divided 50-50 between the two disciplines.
- If one discipline does not run, the prize money will be split equally.

## 12. **Official Ceremonies**

- Competitors are expected to attend the event's social functions. The organising authority may refuse entry to those who do not meet the dress code. Prize winners may forfeit their prizes if they do not attend the prize-giving ceremony.

## 13. **Disclaimer of Liability**

- Competitors participate in the event at their own risk, in accordance with WSRR 4 - Decision to Race.
- The organising authority and its representatives will not accept liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with the event.
- All participants must sign the Disclaimer which is part of the pre registration process.

## 14. **Insurance**

- Each competitor must have valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,500,000 per event.

## 15. Use of Name and Likeness

- By registering for the event, competitors grant the Organising Authority the right to use, modify, and display any images or footage taken during the event for promotional purposes without compensation.

## 16. Travel Infos and Schedule

**Note:** To get the rider benefits — food vouchers, drinks vouchers and the discounted entry fee — you need to sign up in Tier 1 (Early Bird), closing 24/08/2026 at 09:00 CET. These offers are for Tier 1 pre-registered riders only.

### **Venue Location:**

### **Registration:**

Registration is online only and pre-registration is mandatory — there is no on-site registration. Tier 1 (Early Bird) closes 24/08/2026 at 09:00 CET; Tier 2 (Standard, full price) closes 06/10/2026 at 09:00 CET.

Arrival and skippers meeting shall take place on the morning of the first day of competition. Freestyle competition shall take place on-forecast, all competitors shall be alerted via whatsapp and/or email within 24 hours of competition starting - once skippers meeting is complete whatsapp and email shall not be considered official channels of communication (please always check the noticeboard). It is mandatory to attend the skippers meeting to take part in the competition.

### **Beach Access:**

Parking on-site - please ensure you have a ticket.

### **Accommodation:**

Riders can camp within the parking zones overnight - please check ticket machines for parking rates.

### **Travel Tips:**

Closest airports: Rotterdam (30min drive), Amsterdam (60min drive)



Easy access directly by car or van, train/bus or car-share from Amsterdam.  
Unfortunately, we are not able to provide airport shuttle services.

**Food & Party:**

For pre-registered riders (signed-up in the pre-registration phase - before 9:00am CET 24/08/26)

Wed-Thurs: 1x Lunch or Dinner per competition day - depending on timings

Sat-Sun: Breakfast and 1x Meal Voucher per competitor (for tow-in competitors)
